
*Biography of the speakers*



**Pervenche BERÈS – MEP, Member of the "Common Goods and Public Services" & of the "Long-term Investment & Reindustrialisation" Intergroup**

Pervenche Berès is the S&D Coordinator of the Economic and Monetary affairs Committee and a substitute member of the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy, and of the Institutional Affairs Committee. She is also Chair of the PES Social Europe Network. In 2017, she was appointed co-rapporteur on the review of the European supervisory authorities (ESAs). In 2015, she was rapporteur on "a Budgetary capacity for the Eurozone" and rapporteur on "The economic governance framework of EMU: Stocktaking of possible building blocks" in 2014.

A key Member of the European Parliament, Pervenche Berès chaired the Employment and Social Affairs Committee (2009 – 2014) and the Economic and Monetary affairs Committee (2004 – 2009).



**Shadin VIRATHAM – Team Leader, EaSI social finance, DG Empl, European Commission**

Shadin is a team leader within the unit in DG Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion, which is responsible for inclusive entrepreneurship, microfinance and social enterprise. He has been working for the EU institutions since 2015. He leads the team dealing with policies and funding for social finance, including financial instruments and technical assistance, under the EU Programme for Employment and Social Innovation (EaSI).





## **Laurent Zylberberg – Chairman, European Long-Term Investors Association (ELTI)**

Laurent Zylberberg is Chairman of the European Long-Term Investors Association (ELTI) since 2015 and Director of Institutional, International and European Relations for the Caisse des Dépôts Group since 2014. Laurent Zylberberg was a political adviser for various French Ministers (Home office, Defence, Prime Minister's office, Social affairs) from 1989 to 1993 and taught at the Sorbonne University in political science and public law. He was then Social Affairs Counsellor at the French Embassy in London until 1996 and then moved to Brussels to head the European's office of the lobbying company "Euroconsultants". Back to Paris in 1998, he joined France Telecom Group as marketing director for public services, then director for parliamentary affairs. He then became Employee Relations Directors in 2005, first at international level then for the whole Orange Group. In 2011, he was appointed General Manager for Orange Vietnam and came back in France in 2013 when he became Group Chief Compliance Officer. Laurent Zylberberg holds a PhD (1992) in sociology and political science about the history of urbanism in Paris' region.



## **Filippo MUNISTERI – Policy Officer, Relations with European and International Financial Institutions, DG Ecfi, European Commission**

Filippo Munisteri is an economic analyst within the Treasury and Financial directorate at DG Ecfi in the European Commission. Filippo is part of the team coordinating the negotiation of the new InvestEU programme and the relations with the EIB Group and other IFIs. Until 2017, he was employed in Telecom regulation department of DG Cnect, where he dealt with high speed broadband financing and took part in the negotiation of the new Telecom Regulatory Framework.

Prior to joining the European Commission in 2011, he was senior consultant at Deloitte (2007-2011) in the EMEA hub for policy evaluation where he worked on behalf of several international institutions. He also has experience in banking. Filippo holds a master's Degree in economics and Master of Arts in European Economic Affairs from the College of Europe in Bruges, Belgium.



## **Edoardo REVIGLIO – Economist, Cassa Depositi e Prestiti**

Edoardo Reviglio is Chief Economist at "Cassa di Risparmio di Roma" (CDR), Rome. President of International University College of Turin and Professor of economics at LUISS Guido Carli in Rome, he is a member of the Scientific Committee of the Club of Long Term Investors, Paris. In the past he covered various positions in the public sector, including: Chief Economist and Head of the Research Department at Istituto per la Ricostruzione Industriale (IRI) and Member of the Council of Economic Advisers of the Italian Ministry of Economy and Finance.

Professor Reviglio received his BA, Summa Cum Laude, from Yale College; was Research Fellow at the Mathematical Center Vito Volterra (Università di Roma Tor Vergata, 1988-90); Visiting Scholar at the Department of Mathematics of Yale University (1990-1992); Post Doctoral Fellow and Research Associate at the Department of Mathematics of Imperial College, University of London (1992-1994). His fields of research include: banking and finance, international economics, public finance, economic history and law and economics. He is author of ten books and several scientific articles.



## **Sorcha EDWARDS – Housing Europe Secretary General**
